

Hearing aid compatible mobile phones

This range of Hearing Aid compatible mobile telephones has been chosen specifically because they are all easy for everyone to use.



Instead of making things small and complex, with these mobiles things are bigger, louder, clearer and easier to handle!



The mobile phones are well designed and offer a range of useful features such as direct dial memories, easy menu navigation and large fonts. They have good tactile buttons, which are not too small or close together, a vibration alert and most have an emergency SOS button on the back.

These phones are classified as Hearing Aid Compatible (HAC), and most hearing aid users will be able to use them without any problems from interference.

All these mobile phones have Bluetooth, meaning they will work with the Bluetooth headsets & neckloops we supply – see page 184.



All our phones are supplied unlocked (for use on any network) and SIM-Free. You will need to arrange for a SIM card from a mobile phone network operator for use with these phones. These are readily available from supermarkets or your local mobile phone shop. Note: All the Doro mobile phones require a MicroSIM.

Want to take the fuss out of owning a mobile phone?

Fuss free phones is a fixed price, monthly pre-pay mobile network which is available on specially configured Doro 6520 flip mobile phones. The service aims to take the fuss out of using a mobile phone by having real people to help with each call or text message. A team of UK based telephonists are on hand to help, so you don't need to worry about how to read or send a text message, or even find a contact in your phone book! You can also benefit from the no nuisance calls service, where you will only receive calls from people you want to speak to. Doro Secure 580 simple mobile phone

A super simple, easy to use basic mobile phone which can receive all calls and has 4 pre-programmed buttons for dialling out

– to give peace of mind and ensure you can stay in touch.

This phone is durable and splashproof and great for an elderly relative or someone who struggles to use a conventional phone or remember phone numbers.

Ideally the Secure 580 should be set up for the user by a relative or friend. As it has no conventional keypad, programming requires a little patience and can be fiddly but is straightforward and well-explained in the instructions.



Emergency button on back

It is also possible to register for an online My Doro Manager account so you can set-up and manage the Secure 580 remotely. This is easier and saves time but it will use 3G to sync with the phone so make sure you have an internet data allowance as part of your mobile phone contract.

As well as the SOS assistance button on the back, this phone has a really nice safety timer feature, which if not cleared (eg after taking a bath), automatically sends a text to pre-set numbers, along with GPS information to let people know where you are.

A recommended choice for people with memory loss or visual impairment. We particularly like the ruggedness and simplicity of this phone and the ability to create a Whitelist where the phone will only accept incoming calls from pre-approved numbers.

Note: the Secure 580 requires a MicroSIM card.

Doro 5516

A practical and modern yet classic-looking mobile phone, making it simple to call, text and take pictures with, along with a rear SOS assistance button for added safety.

The 'bar' design is traditional and sturdy, making it easy to hold, with a large clear screen. The buttons on the 5516 are not as large as on other Doro mobile phone models, although they are nicely separated. There are dedicated short-cut buttons for the camera, torch & messages.



A good sturdy phone with a classic design, combining great sound and useful features.

Doro 6520

A lightweight clamshell mobile phone with large 2.8" display, robust build and simple layout. The 6520 is a 'hybrid' phone – while it isn't a smartphone, it does have internet access for emails and weather updates and remote access via My Doro Manager.



Customers find the clear, well separated buttons easy to use and the flip design particularly good. The ability to set up the phone remotely using the Doro software is a useful one if you have a technosavvy friend or family member who isn't nearby.

Note, we would recommend a SIM plan with a data allowance if you intend to use the internet features.

Doro 6530

The 6530 is very similar to the 6520 but with the addition of an attractive external display, camera flash, GPS positioning and a charging cradle included in the box.

The 6530 is the most advanced of our range of mobile phones and is compatible with Doro Connect & Care, an easy to use subscription service that helps you create a network of support – friends, family and people you trust who you can contact quickly and easily if you need help.



This phone is the 'big brother' to the 6520 with some nice additional features for the more advanced user. The external display is particularly popular.

Note, we would recommend a SIM plan with a data allowance if you intend to use these features.

Amplicomms PowerTel M7510-3G

The PowerTel M7510-3G is a compact flip phone with a nice range of features, including a camera which can take both photos and video. An unusual but handy function is the option to schedule power on/off times for the phone so you can set it to automatically turn itself off at night time, to save battery.



The M7510-3G is a nice design with a very large and clear external display. It has some good features and a good volume level with a boost button.



Amplicomms PowerTel M7000i

A very loud, easy to use flip phone with a large screen and a good loud ringing sound.

In the opinion of our evaluation panel, the Amplicomms M7000i is a really good phone, with a more

comprehensive range of features than most in our range – making it excellent value for money.

Comparative listening loudness

While manufacturers of phones often give figures in decibels for the amplification levels of the phones, we don't quote these as there is no guarantee of consistency of measurement across manufacturers. Instead we have our own system of 'blobs' which give an indication of the maximum listening volume level in a comparative manner.

Blob ratings

(approximate dB equivalent)

- 10 dB and above
- 20 dB and above
- 30 dB and above
- 40 dB and above
- 50 dB and above

Our blob ratings are comparable across all our phones

Notes to this chart:

1 The T3/M3 and T4/M4 indications by the phones, is an American standard used to rate how good a mobile phone is when used with a hearing aid on 'T' and also on 'M'. A performance level of 3 or 4 is considered acceptable, although some hearing aid users with older hearing aids may still experience problems. 

This phone has advanced connectivity features such as 4G, GPS positioning and WiFi.

In our view this phone is really nicely designed and well-thought out. It is a high quality phone and a great introduction to smartphones. We really like the step-by-step guides and friendly verbs to help you find what you would like to do, eg: send, view, call. The large screen is particularly nice and clear.

In our opinion the M9500 is easy to navigate with large, well-designed touch screen buttons. The software is more specialised than the previous M9000 and the screen is larger. It also has excellent volume and sound as well as a nice selection of advanced settings, limiting down the menu options you have regular access to. This is a great smartphone for anyone who is not familiar with touchscreen devices.

All the products shown here are suitable for use with hearing aid & cochlear implant users who have a loop program.

Family members without a hearing loss can use the cordless phone just like a regular phone, plus there is a volume booster mode for those moments when

users are not wearing their hearing aids.

The phone's features include 12 ring tones, dedicated volume buttons, volume boost button, hands free speakerphone and a vibrate function.
